## **1B/2B/1A Boys**


Parth Jain secured a 6th place finish in singles for Charles Wright Academy. Parth reached the semifinals before facing the eventual state champion.

# Pro Tip: The Art of the Drop Shot Submitted by Allan Overland

The drop shot is a great tactic as players are responding to the greater pace and depth generated in today's game by often positioning themselves farther and farther behind the baseline, giving their opponents more court to hit in front of them. As a result, the drop shot is an effective way to either hit an outright winner or produce an error by a player positioned behind the baseline, particularly if they are not expecting it. Here are some tips to improve your drop shot:

- Disguise is key. Always start the shot *exactly* as if you are going to hit a ground stroke and take the racquet head back above your wrist. Note: you can also hit the drop shot off a backhand slice preparation.
- Wait until after the ball bounces to change your grip to a continental grip (if necessary).
- Again, after the bounce, open the racquet face as little as possible and hit downward with a slice motion (much like a volley, but with more follow through).
- Try to hit the shot with a small arc (so that the ball bounces more in place) with a moderate amount of underspin.
- Unless you have placed the ball too far into the court, follow the shot into the net to put more pressure on your opponent. Unless they make a great passing shot, you can usually volley the reply into the open court for a winner.
