Getting Started with Junior Tennis Tournaments Submitted by Head Pro Allan Overland

Tennis pros encourage junior players to play in tournaments to sharpen their games

and partake in a great experience that simply can't be duplicated in any other way.

When I was an aspiring junior player, regional tournaments were only held June through August, and everyone played in the same tournaments. Today, regional

tournaments are available to players 12 months out of the year, and for different levels of play. If you are new to tournament play, I thought the following information would help you get started.

Obtain a USTA membership. By getting a family or junior-only membership, a junior is eligible to sign up for USTA sanctioned tournaments. UTR tournaments are also offered, but I recommend USTA tournaments first and foremost for the number of tournaments offered and the different age divisions available. To register for a USTA membership, go to usta.com and click "Join" in the upper right-hand corner.

Get to know your level of tournament play. At the club, we have 6 levels of play, with level 1.0 being beginner and level 6.0 being advanced. However, the USTA now rates the level of tournament play the opposite way, with 7 levels of tournament play. Level 7 is the lowest and Level 1 is the highest. Once a junior obtains a rating of at least level 3.0, then it is time to begin considering tournament play. Here is a guide to recommended tournament levels based on club levels:

Level 7 = BETC ratings of 3.0-4.0

Level 6 = BETC ratings of 4.0-5.0

Level 5 = BETC ratings of 5.0-6.0

Levels 4 = BETC rating of 6.0

Levels 3, 2, 1 (National championships) = High regional ranking (top 5)

Play in singles and doubles events. USTA sanctioned tournaments feature a double elimination format for singles events, which is great for juniors to gain more match play experience. Doubles events are typically single elimination but offer juniors still more experience and a chance to work on different parts of their games.

Consult your BETC coach for more information. We are here to help you with all aspects of your tennis experience, including recommending what tournament levels of play you should consider and how to prepare your game for tournament play. Let's go!





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BETC Juniors at State
